Amendment 2 (two) to CVWC Standing Rules. Passed at the August 2008 meeting.

16. Mel Moose Award

a) The Mel Moose Award is an annual presentation to a club member, in good standing, who has been voted for by club members. This vote is by ballot at the **September** meeting.

b) Members considered for the award should exemplify by activity and spirit the goals of the club specified by the PURPOSE statement, Article II, in the By-Laws.

c) The award recipient's name will be inscribed on the permanent Mel Moose plaque to be maintained at the club meeting facility.

d) The award recipient will be presented with a Certificate of Recognition and a \$100 award at the **October** meeting.

e) The award announcement should be published in the local newspaper.

f) The plaque should be of appropriate size to accommodate an annual update of recipient name and date for several years. The Certificate of Recognition shall be full colored on bonded paper in a 10 x 14 glassed frame.

g) A recipient is ineligible for the award for the subsequent two years.

h) Preparation of the plaque, Certificate of Recognition, and newspaper article is the responsibility of the Secretary.

14. Membership dues

a) Regular membership - \$24.00 per year, (1 January – 31 December);
